





Chronicle workshops

- A way to find out what has happened for a group of people
- Involved a broad selection of fishermen
- Consisted of three rounds:
 - 1. Significant events
 - 2. Significant actors
 - 3. Consequences experienced by participants



- 6. Promote knowledge exchange


